
COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Would you rather be able to teleport anywhere or be able to read minds?

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Psalm 119:1-32 (or all of 119 if you want to).

DIG: How does this psalm show the importance of God's Word?

How many ways does this psalm refer to God's Word? Are there any verses that don't refer to it? Why does the psalmist spend so much time describing God's Word?

How has the truth of Scripture impacted your life? How do you best implement change in your life from the Bible (reading, listening, speaking, etc.)?

CHALLENGE: Think of your daily and weekly rhythms and activities. How often is studying the Bible a part of those rhythms? If you are not studying and living out God's Word as often as you want to be, there is no better time to start than right now! Be encouraged that God's plan for you is continually unfolding, and He wants you to follow along in the goodness He has planned for you.
